come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Job Benton*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Job Benton*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

*South West of the New Beginning a Picta to be amongst
two Hickorys point to Thomas Sayers Corner on
the West Bank of Pine Bluff then with his line
North twenty East crossing a Bent of the Creek
thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to a stake
Hickory Post Oak and Red Oak near me then
to a Stake then North twenty West thirty one Chains
and Sixty three Links to a Stake and three Pines then
South twenty West thirty one Chains and Sixty three
Links to a Stake and three Pines then South twenty East
thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to the Beginning
as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Job**

Benton his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Job Benton*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
