K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Joseph Corbett*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Joseph Corbett*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred

Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the side of Drumming Creek and the West side of Little
Branch Beginning at a Pine and runs South one
hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Pine, then
West One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a small
Pine near Judith Corbett's Line, then North one
hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Stake, then
East One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to the
Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Joseph Corbett his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Joseph Corbett*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
