come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Joshua Burris Junr.*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Joshua Burris Junr.*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

*South West of Reddison the Dyans of Island Creek
Beginning at a Hickory amongst three Black Jacks
and a pine and Run thence South fifty six East thirty
one chains and Sixty three Links to a stake two pines and
two Black Jacks then North forty four East thirty one
chains and Sixty three Links to a pine by three pines
Runners then South fifty six West thirty one chains
and Sixty Links to a stake amongst two pines then
North forty four West thirty one chains and Sixty
three Links to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Joshua*
Burris Junr. his Heirs

and Assigns, forever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Joshua Burris*
Junr. shall cause this Grant to be

registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*,
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
