

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Joseph Thomson* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Joseph Thomson* a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Inson*

*North West of Pee Dee on the Divvins of Savannah Creek Beginning at Stake amongst three pines To him Smiths Corner and thence north South sixteen East thirty seven chains to a Stake as well to begin Kings Corner then with the Course of his Marked Trees North ten East Sixty four chains and Sixty three Links to his Corner Stake amongst two pines and post Oak beam Course twenty four chains to a Corner then North Eighty West forty two chains to a Corner thence South twenty four chains to a pine thence South twenty four East seven chains and fifty Links to a Stake amongst two post Oaks and Hickory near Abraham Byline then North Eighty two East eight chains twenty five Links to a post Oak corner amongst three pines thence South seven East twenty six chains to the Beginning as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods; Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Joseph Thomson* his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Joseph Thomson* shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Inson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.*
