To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

KNOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Lawrence Franklin*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Lawrence Franklin*, a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred & four

Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

South West of Pewee Beginning at a Hickory in Lawrence Franklins line on a Hill saide South of Wilkeys Mile Creek a prong of Jones Creek amongst three Hickorys and a white Oak Pointers to Tilmanis Homs Beginning corner and running with Hobbs line North Seventy five West Fifteen Chains to a Rock in said line on Hill side marked thus L F amongst Hickory Poplar and White Oak Pointers then South fifteen West ten Chains to a corner in Edwards line then with his line South ten East & thirty Chains and fifty Links to a corner then with his other line North Seventy five West thirty three Chains to a corner then South Fifteen West nineteen Chains to a corner then South twenty five & One thirty five Chains to a corner then North fifteen East Fifty five Chains and fifty Links running to and with said Franklin line to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Lawrence Franklin*

his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Lawrence Franklin*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
