come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Levi Glass*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Levi Glass*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the North East side of Hughes Marsh below Lumber Bridge
and joining Michael Skewers Line and said Glass line
Beginning at a Pine at one end of a Tree in said Skewers Line
and running along and beyond said Skewers Line North
Twenty one West forty three chains four eight Links to a Stake
then South Sixty nine West Twenty three chains to a Stake then
South Twenty one East forty three chains four eight Links to a
Stake then North Sixty nine East Sixty three chains to the
Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Levi Glass his Heirs
and Afflins, for ever, Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Levi Glass shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
