K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Levy Prular*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Levy Prular*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*Lying on the West side of Lane Creek Beginning
at a Hickory Sapling in Prular's old line and
Running North forty two West thirty one Chains and
Twenty Links crossing of the Bigg Branch to a stake
between three the house thence South forty Eight West
thirty one Chains and Twenty Links to a stake between
two pines thence South forty two East thirty one Chains
and Twenty Links to a stake between a White Oak and
a red Oak thence North forty Eight East thirty one
Chains and Twenty Links to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Levy*

Prular his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Levy Prular*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
