K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Loth Stiman*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Loth Stiman*
a Tract of Land, containing
Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the West side of Lounsbury's Branch beginning
at a Pine about two Poles from the said Branch and
hundred and fifty Yards below, and at the head of said
Branch and Run West One hundred and twenty seven Poles
to a Stake and three Poles point to then South two hundred
and fifty four Poles to a Stake then East One hundred and
Twenty seven Poles to a Stake, thence North two hundred
and fifty four Poles to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Loth Stiman his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Loth Stiman*
shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
