K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by Michael Barnes
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said Michael Barnes
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of Bladen

On the East side of Little Hoggs Swamp beginning at a
Pine in Michael Barnes old Line running South Eighty
Poles to a stake in Great Hoggs Swamp, then East One
hundred and Sixty Poles to a stake, then North One
hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a stake, then West
Sixty Poles to Barnes corner then North eighty two West
Ninety Poles to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Michael Barnes his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said Michael Barnes

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of Bladen
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
