Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by Moses Homes
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said Moses Homes
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of Bladen

In gentle Swamps Beginning at a Pine in a
Savannah on the West side of the said Swamp
and Running South Twenty East One hundred
and forty Pole to a stake, thence North Twenty
East One hundred and fifteen Pole to a stake
thence North Twenty West One hundred and
forty Pole to a stake thence South Twenty
West One hundred and fifteen Pole to the

Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Moses Homes his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said Moses Homes

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of Bladen
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
