To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

**K**NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Moses Turner*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Moses Turner* a Tract of Land, containing One hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

East of Gum Swamp beginning at a post Oak in *Thomas Turner's* Wood Line amongst two pines and running with his line North Eighty East Nineteen Chains to his corner amongst two pines and a post Oak and then North Eighty East Twelve Chains and Sixty three links to a Stake amongst three pines and a post Oak between North fifteen West thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to a Stake amongst three pines then South Eighty West thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to a corner then South fifteen East Thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Moses*

*Turner* his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Moses Turner* shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
