to a Stake amongst three pines and a post Oak then ~
North fifteen West thirty one Chains and Sixty three ~
Links to a Stake amongst three pines then South Eighty
West thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to a corner
then South fifteen East thirty one Chains and Sixty three
Links to the Beginning.*
