K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Peter Jackson*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Peter Jackson*
a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*On the West side of Pee Dee on the Fall Branch
Beginning at a Turkey Oak above the plantation
and Run thence South twenty three West six by
three Chains and twenty four Links to a stake and
three post Oaks, then South sixty seven East thirty
one Chains and Sixty three Links crossing a path
to a stone safe a safe two post Oaks and Red Oak
near a Spring then North twenty three East Sixty
three Chains and twenty four Links crossing Manger Road
beginning at a Turkey Oak North Sixty seven West thirty one Chains
to the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear together with all Woods,*

Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Peter*
Jackson

his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Peter Jackson*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
