K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Peter Meshaw* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Peter Meshaw* a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the Horse Shoe Beginning at a Pine on the East side of the Horse Shoe and running D. West thro' the Horse Shoe One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Red Oak then D. South One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Maple, thence D. East thro' the Horse Shoe One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Maple by a Pine, thence D. North One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to the Beginning Corner

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Peter Meshaw his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Peter Meshaw*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
