

To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Richard Leek*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Richard Leek*, a Tract of Land, containing *Fifty one* Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

North East of Padded Beginning at a White Oak Ephraim Siles Beginning Corner on the River Bank (and Running) with his line North ten East forty three Chains to Siles Corner continuing the same Course four Chains to a corner in or near Samuel David's line then the Course of his line South forty two East twenty six Chains to a stake two Red Oaks and a Hickory in said line then with the Mary Foreman's line South forty four West thirty eight Chains and then Linke to the River

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Richard Leek* his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Richard Leek*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
