come, Greeting.

**K** NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of  
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid  
into our Treasury by *Robert Hall*,  
have Given and Granted, and by these  
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Robert Hall*,  
a Tract of Land, containing

*One hundred*  
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

*South West of Pee Dee Beginning at a Poplar Oak amongst  
three Black Jacks pointers about fifty yards from Road  
and thence North forty two West thirty one Chains and  
Sixty three Links crossing the Road to a stake three times  
a hickory and Black Jack then South forty eight West  
thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to a stake and  
four times then South forty two East thirty one Chains  
and Sixty three Links to a corner then North forty eight  
East thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to the  
Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear, together with all Woods,  
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the  
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Robert*

*Hall* his Heirs and  
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money  
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may  
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Robert Hall*

shall cause this Grant to  
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*,  
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise  
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
