KNOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Robert W. Kenney*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Robert W. Kenney* a Tract of Land, containing **Thirty-eight** Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*,

On the South West side of Babcock River on the North side of Bearwings Branch Beginning at Edward Bryan's corner being a small Pine and Running North thirty three West One hundred and Twenty two Rods to William McRees corner then South West One hundred and sixteen Rods to Edward Davis's Line to a small Pine, then North Eighty two East One hundred and five Rods to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Robert W. Kenney his Heirs and Affigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Robert W. Kenney* shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
