K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by Robert Starkey
have Given, and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said Robert Starkey
a Tract of Land, containing
Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of Bladen

On the Mile Branch Displace Beginning at a Pine
and D. West thirty One Chains and Sixty two Links
to a Stake by a Pine. thence D. ~~West~~ ^{North} Sixty three Chains
and Twenty four Links to a Stake. thence D. East
thirty One Chains and Sixty two Links to a Stake
thence D. South Sixty three Chains and Twenty Links
to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Robert Starkey his Heirs and
Affigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said Robert Starkey
shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of Bladen
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
