

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Robert Thomas*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Robert Thomas* a Tract of Land, containing

Six hundred forty

Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

East of Gum Swamp Beginning at a pine amongst three pines on the West side of Deep Creek and Runs thence South Fifty eight West seven Chains and Eighty two Links to a stake amongst three pines in the second line of a hundred Acres Survey of said Thomas then with this line North forty one West twenty three Chains and twenty three Links to a corner then with his other line South forty one West forty Chains to his Beginning post Oak amongst a post Oak and two pines then with Moses Turners second line North fifty West thirty one Chains and sixty three Links to his Corner Stake amongst three pines thence North thirty three West twelve Chains to a pine amongst three pines on the East side of a large Bay Pond then North three West forty one Chains and fifty links to a pine amongst three pines then North forty five East eighty one Chains to a corner then South Eight East one hundred and twenty four Chains to a corner then North fifty eight West five Chains to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Robert Thomas* his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Robert Thomas* shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
