Presents do Give and Grant unto the said Samuel Bone
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred

Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

On the South side of Drowning Swamp and South side
of Ashhole Swamp Beginning at a Pine West of a
Small Pond about a Quarter of a mile above Northern
pole bearing old Improvements Running West Ninety
Pole to a Pine then North one hundred and Eighty
Pole to a Stake among three Pine Pointers then
East ninety Pole to a Stake then Direct to the
Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Samuel Bone

his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Samuel Bone

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of Bladen

within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
