come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Samuel Salisbury* *Chair*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Samuel Salisbury*
Chair a Tract of Land, containing
Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

North East of Redd and West of Little Rivers
Little Town Creek known by the name of Salisbury
Plain Beginning at a pine near the Foxgripe Church
in Nicholas Christian's line and John W. Perry's fourth
corner then Running with W. Perry's line North twenty
seven West forty five chains to a stake by a pine in corner
Two pines and black Jacks then North fifty six East
forty six chains to a corner then South twenty seven

East forty five chains to a corner then South fifty six
West fifty six chains to a post on Nicholas Christian's corner then with
as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Samuel*
Salisbury *Chair* his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Samuel Salisbury*
Chair shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.

IN TESTIMONY whereof, we have caused our Great Seal to be

Kinston, the *third* Day of *September*
in the *fourth* Year of our Independence, and in the
Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and *seventy nine*.
