K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Samuel Williams*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Samuel Williams*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

*N. East of Pee Dee on the Drains of Hamors Creek
Beginning at a Turkey Oak on the East side of a small
Drain and Run thence West thirty one Chains and
Sixty three Links to a Stake amongst a Red Oak
Black Jack and pine then North thirty one Chains
and Sixty three Links to a Corner then East thirty one
Chains and Sixty three Links to a Corner then South
thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to the
Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Samuel*
Williams his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Samuel Williams*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
