**K**NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Samuel Williams*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Samuel Williams*, a Tract of Land, containing One hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

No. Coast of Pee Dee on the Branches of Hamors Creek  
(Beginning) at a Turkey Oak on the East side of a small  
Branch and Runs thence West thirty one Chains and  
Sixty three Links to a Stake amongst a Red Oak &  
Black Jack and pine then North thirty one Chains  
and Sixty three Links to a corner then East thirty one  
Chains and Sixty three Links to a corner then South  
thirty one Chains and Sixty three Links to the  
Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,  
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the  
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Samuel Williams*

his Heirs and  
*Williams* Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money  
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may  
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Samuel Williams*  
shall cause this Grant to  
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*  
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise  
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
