To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Stephen Barfield*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Stephen Barfield*
a Tract of Land, containing

Three hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Catawba*
On the North side of *Ga. way* (Beginning at a Stake at the Run and
Running on *Barney Horns* Line formerly *Barney's* North
Fifty five degrees East Seven Chains and fifty Links to a Black
Stump at the Edge of *Ga. way* Swamp thence eight Chains and fifty
Links to a Pine said *Horns* corner forty Chains to a Pine thence
South thirty seven degrees East seven hundred Chains to a Stake
on *Jas. H. Hearn's* Line thence down the said Line South
Fifty five degrees West forty Chains to a Stake on *Ga. way* run
then the various courses of said Run to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Stephen Barfield his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Stephen Barfield*
shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anderson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
