K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Stephen Daniel*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Stephen Daniel*
a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the South side of the White Marsh Spring Samuel Waters's
upper corner and out along W. Greene Line and Down said
for complement Beginning at a White Oak Samuel Waters's upper
corner and Running South forty One East Two hundred and Twenty
One Pole to a Pine then South forty nine West One hundred and
Seventy Poles to a small Pine, then South Eighty two West
One hundred and six Poles to a Stake then North nineteen
East Two hundred and Twenty five Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Stephen Daniel his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Stephen Daniel*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
