come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Stephen Miller*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Stephen Miller*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

*South West of Pec Dee on the Means of Lick Creek
Beginning at a Turkey Oak near said Miller line on
the Bank of a small Branch and Running thence North
Twenty East Thirty six Chains and Sixty Links to a
Corner then North forty four West Thirty Chains to a
Corner then South twenty West Thirty six Chains and
Sixty Links crossing the Lower Road to ad the line of the
Black Jacks in said Miller line then South forty
four East thirty Chains with his line to the Beginning.*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Stephen
Miller* his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Stephen Miller*
shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
