K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Stephen Smith*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Stephen Smith*

a Tract of Land, containing
One hundred and fifty
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*Con Jockey and Persimmon Branch Beginning at a
White Oak on the South side of Persimmon Branch
near Jockey and Running D South One hundred and
fifty five Poles to a water Oak, thence D. East One
hundred and fifty five Poles to a Stake by a water
Oak, thence D. North One hundred and fifty five
Poles to a Stake, thence D. West One hundred and
fifty five Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Stephen Smith his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Stephen Smith*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
