K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Stephen Tompkins* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Stephen Tompkins* a Tract of Land, containing

Twenty five Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

South West of Pee Dee on the Divans of Hickelberry Beginning at a White Oak Sapling amonged three hickoms in Samuel Blackfords line and Running with said line South Two East five Chains to a corner in John Sepwers line then with his line North Fifty seven West thirty five Chains and Seventy five Linhs to a stake in his other line then with it North Sixty East ten Chains crossing the Road to a corner then South sixty Eight East thirty four Chains and thirty Links to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Stephen Tompkins* his Heirs and Aliens, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Stephen Tompkins* shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
