come, Greeting.*

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Sterling Williamson*,
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Sterling Williamson*,
a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson* -
North East of Great Pee Dee on the East side of Jones
Crack Beginning at a pine amongst three pines and running
thence South Eighty East forty four Chams and Twenty
three Links to a stake amongst three pines near a large Pond
thence South ten West forty four Chams and Seventy three
Links to a corner thence North Eighty West forty four Chams
and Seventy three Links to a corner thence North ten East
forty four Chams and Seventy three Links to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Sterling*
Williamson his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Sterling Williamson*
shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
