K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Thomas Davis*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Thomas Davis*

a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On a Gum Pond near the Branches of Slade Swamp
Beginning at a large Cedar near Slenders Branch and
Running West North and Chain and Sixty three Links
to a Stake and two Pines, then South Sixty three Links
and Twenty six Links to a Stake and two Pines, then
East thirty one Chain and Sixty three Links to a
Stake, then North Sixty three Chain and Twenty six
Links to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Thomas Davis his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

Thomas Davis shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
