To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *Thomas Lockery*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Thomas Lockery*, a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred

Acres, lying and being in our County of *UNSON*

North East of Pee Dee on the Banks of Car Hedges Creek Beginning at a Red Oak amongst three Black Jacks and Running thence North five West three Chains and Eighty Links to a stake Red Oak and two Black Jacks in George Webb's Line then with this line North thirty six East five Chains to a stake amongst Black Jacks pine and Chestnut Oak then with his other line North fifty four West three Chains and Sixteen Links to a Sassafras two Black Oaks and a pine in said Line then South Eighty seven East three Chains and fifty Links to a stake amongst a pine two Black Jacks then South twenty East one hundred Chains to a Corner then North twenty five West one hundred and seven Chains and fifty Links to a corner then North five West seven Chains to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *Thomas Lockery* his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Thomas Lockery*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Unson*, within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
