come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Thomas Haynes*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Thomas Haynes*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*
On both sides of the Beavindam Swamp (beginning) at
a small White Oak running West One hundred and
Twenty seven Poles to a Stake and three Pines, thence
North One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to a Stake
thence East One hundred and Twenty seven Poles to
a Stake, thence South One hundred and Twenty seven
Poles to the (beginning)

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Thomas Haynes his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Thomas Haynes*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
