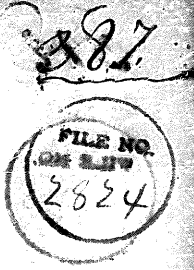


To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.



K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Thomas Loe*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Thomas Loe*
a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the West side of Hoggs Swamp Beginning at
a Spruce Pine in William Solers Land and running
South Two hundred and Twenty Poles to two Pines and a white
Oak in the edge of a Bay, then West One hundred and Twenty
Nine Poles to a Stake, then North One hundred and Eighty two
Poles to a Stake, then South Sixty East One hundred and eight
Poles to Solers corner then North Twenty East One hundred
and five Poles to a Stake then East forty Poles to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Thomas Loe his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Thomas Loe*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
