K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *Turner Davis*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *Turner Davis*

Two hundred a Tract of Land, containing

Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*Lying near Branches Creek on the Dry Sand Beginning
at a Red Oak and Running N. West thirty One chains
and Sixty two Links to a white Oak, thence N. South
Sixty three chains and Twenty four Links to a Pine
thence N. East thirty One chains and Sixty two
Links to a Stake, thence N. North Sixty three chains
Twenty four Links to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

Turner Davis his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *Turner Davis*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
