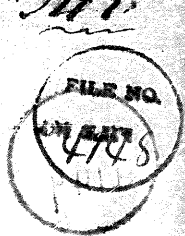


To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.



K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *William Baker*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Baker*, a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred and fifty Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

North East of Pee Dee beginning at John Coleman's corner pine on the West side of a Branch and running with Coleman's marked trees South twenty three East seven Chains and fifty to a Whitewater among Bassafras Black Gums and White Oak near a Branch then North sixty five East forty Nine Chains and fifty three Links crossing the Branch to and with Solomon Brothers' line to a pine two Chestnut Oaks in said line then North Twenty three West thirty one Chains to a corner about sixty five West forty Nine Chains and forty three links to a stake and Turkey Oak among three pines South Twenty three East Twenty three Chains and fifty Links to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *William Baker* his Heirs

and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Baker*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*, within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.

IN TESTIMONY whereof, we have caused our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS *RICHARD CASWELL*, Esquire, our Governor, Captain-General, and Commander in Chief, at *Kinston*, the *third* Day of *September* in the *fourth* Year of our Independence, and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and *seventy nine*.
