K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *William Bryan* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Bryan* a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On both sides of Rudy Branch and West side of Thomas Bryans Swamp above William Garrisons Beginning at a Pine and running North thirty five Chains to a Stake then West Twenty eight Chains and Thirteen Links to a Stake, then South thirty five Chains to a Stake, then East Twenty eight Chains and thirty seven Links to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

William Bryan his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Bryan*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
