K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *William Hamon* have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Hamon* a Tract of Land, containing

Two hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*

South West of Pee Dee on Hurricane Branch of Brown Creek
(Beginning) at a hickory among a pine post Oak and black Jack
near Shadrach Densons line and Runs the course of his line
South Sixty five West fifteen Chains and two seven links to a stake
White Oak Red Oak and Sweet Gum by a branch in Hannah Chies line then
with her line South twenty five East forty seven the branch to an Chain and twenty five links to a
white Oak corner then with her other line South twenty five West forty seven a branch to a
Chain to a stake in said line and the corner of a two hundred acres Survey then with said
line South twenty five East forty seven Chains and twenty five links to a black Jack
central to three Black Jacks then North twenty five East thirty seven a Chain to a
corner then North twenty five West twenty three Chains to the Beginning.
as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *William*
Hamon his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Hamon*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
