To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *William Hendley*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Hendley*, a Tract of Land, containing

Thirty two and a half Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*,

North East of Redwood and East of Little River on the Left Branch of Buffalo Beginning at William Pickens Corner Stake amongst four Black Jacks and Run with his line West thirty three chains to a black Jack then South thirty one East twenty four chains and fifty links to a Stake amongst two post Oaks and two pines then North East East three chains to a stake in Zachariah Smiths line then with his line North ten West thirteen chains and fifty links to a stake amongst two black Jacks a post Oak and pine then with his line North Eighty East Sixty three chains and twenty five links to a stake amongst a black Oak and three white Oaks then South Eighty three West forty two chains and fifty links to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *William Hendley* his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Hendley* shall cause this Grant to

be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
