

To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *William Hollifield*,
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Hollifield*,
a Tract of Land, containing

three hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

*South West of the Head of Jones Creek beginning at a hickory should second corner
East of the North prong of Jones Creek and runs with the North fifteen West of same
the Creek twenty four chains and fifty links to a pine in a line then South twenty two West forty eight chains crossing a branch to a Water Oak in
Small Branch by two sweet gums and a white Oak then South twenty six East twelve
chains and seventy links to a red Oak by two white Oaks in Common Jones line then
with his line North twenty one and a half East thirty chains and fifty links
to a stake a gum Red Oak and Post then with his other line South eighteen and
a half East fifty four chains and seventy eight links to a White Oak the
beginning corner of said Survey then the Reverse course of the fourth line
South twenty one and a half West thirty five chains and fifty links to a red Oak by a
hickory and a red Oak in said line then South five East forty one and a half chains and
Oak to a black Jack and Post Oak then North twenty five East thirty chains and fifty links
to a stake three Oaks Jacks and a pine or a white Oak Red Oak then South ten East fifty chains and
beginning as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,*

Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *William*
Hollifield his Heirs

and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Hollifield*

shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson*,
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
