come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by *William Martam*, have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Martam*, a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred and fifty

Acres, lying and being in our County of *Anson*.

South West of Bee Deon the Branch of Buffalo Beginning at a Red Oak in the Bank of Fishing Branch in Thomas Woods line and running with it South twenty five West eight Chains and Sixty seven links to a Red Oak then South twenty eight West seven Chains and fifty links to a stake in John Higdon's line amongst three pines then with his line North thirty five West twenty eight Chains and fifty links to a stake Post Oak and pine then South Sixty five West Eleven Chains and Seventy Six links to a pine by two pines and a blue hick then North Sixty West sixteen Chains and Sixty one links to a pine on the top of Turkey Cock Hill then North twenty six West thirty six Chains and fifty links to a stake amongst two pines and a blue Oak in Andrew Ropes line then with his line North Sixty seven East forty eight Chains to a corner then South sixteen East forty three Chains to the Beginning.

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said *William Martam* his Heirs and

Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Martam*

shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Anson* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
