

To all to whom these Presents sh^{ll} come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted; paid into our Treasury by *William Moore* —

have Given and Granted, and by these Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Moore* — a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

On the North side of Drowning Creek and North side of Holly Swamp including Richard Bailey's old Improvements Beginning at a point about 300 Yards below said Improvement near the Swamp sides running North westerly to a Stake that line hundred and Eighty Yards to a Stake South westerly to a Stake that line to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods, Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

William Moore his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

William Moore shall cause this Grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen* within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect.
