

To all to whom these Presents shall
come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *William Sallor*
have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Sallor*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*
On the East side of the North West River on Jones Creek Swamp
about a Mile from the Indian Creek Beginning at a Pine on the
East side of said Swamp within about 50 Yards of the Swamp
Running North Eighteen Poles to a Stake, then West ninety Poles
to a Stake, then South One hundred and Eighty Poles to a Stake
then East ninety Poles to the Beginning

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

William Sallor his Heirs and
Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said *William Sallor*

shall cause this Grant to
be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
