come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *William Shuckler*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Shuckler*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of

Bladen

*On the South side of Cabbages Swamp (Beginning) at a
Stake where his own Line and Moses Coleman's Line joins
and Running with his own Line South Sixty West One
hundred and forty seven Pole to a Stake and Two Pine
Pointers, then South Thirty East One hundred and
Nine Pole to a Stake and Three Pine Pointers thence
North Sixty East One hundred and forty seven Pole
to Moses Coleman's Line then along his Line South
Thirty West One hundred and nine Pole to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

William Shuckler his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

William Shuckler shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
