come, Greeting.

K NOW YE, That We, for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Fifty Shillings for every Hundred Acres hereby granted, paid
into our Treasury by *William Thomson*

have Given and Granted, and by these
Presents do Give and Grant unto the said *William Thomson*
a Tract of Land, containing

One hundred
Acres, lying and being in our County of *Bladen*

*On the West side of Drowning Creek and on the West side
of Hoggs Swamp and East side of Ushpole Beginning at his
own old upper Line at a small Pine Running North Twenty
five East One hundred and Eighty Poles to a Stake in
Arhuo Lamps Line then North Sixty five West ninety Poles
to a small Pine, then South Twenty five West One hundred
and Eighty Poles to his Line then South Sixty five West East
Ninety Poles Direct with his Line to the Beginning*

as by the Plat hereunto annexed doth appear; together with all Woods,
Waters, Mines, Minerals, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the
said Land belonging or appertaining: To hold to the said

William Thomson his Heirs
and Assigns, for ever. Yielding and paying to us such Sums of Money
yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from Time to Time may
direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said

William Thomson shall cause this Grant to be
registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Bladen*
within Twelve Months from the Date hereof, otherwise
the same shall be void and of no Effect.
