

Iredell of North Carolina



The Iredells descend from Francis Iredell who married Margaret McCulloh of Belfast Lough, the seat of Lord Dufferin, late Governor General of India.



James Iredell was born 10/5/1751 in Lewes, England and died 10/20/1799. He was one of the original Justices of the Supreme Court of the United States. He was appointed by President George Washington and served from 1790 until his death in 1799.

James Iredell was born in Lewes, England, the oldest of five children of a Bristol merchant. The failure of his father's business (and health) impelled James to emigrate to the Colonies in 1767 at the age of 17. Relatives assisted him in obtaining a position in the customs service as deputy collector, or comptroller, of the port of Edenton, North

Carolina. While working at the customs house, Iredell read law under Samuel Johnston (later governor of North Carolina), began the practice of law and was admitted to the bar in 1771. The grandson of a clergyman, he was a devout Anglican throughout his life and his writings display an interest in spirituality and metaphysics beyond a simple attachment to organized religion.

In 1773, Iredell married Johnston's sister Hannah and the two had four children. Issue.

- Frances Lenox Iredell married 4/10/1849, Dr. Charles Earl Johnson of Raleigh, North Carolina, Surgeon General during the War Between the States and son of Charles E. Johnson of Chowan County, North Carolina. Issue:
