

In the Name of God Amen February ye 14th 1771 I Jeram Campen being sick and weak But of perfect mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God and caring to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I doe make and ordaine this my Last Will and Testament viz. and first of all and principally I Recommend my Soul to the hands of God that gave it Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again through the mighty power of God. and as to my Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like Decent manner at the Discretion of my Exrs and as to Touching such Worldly Goods as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this Life I Give and Devise in manner and form Following

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Campen one Negro Wench known by the Name of Asie and one Negro Girl known by the Name of Rose one Case of Drawers one Lining White one feather Bed and furniture one Iron pot all the Cattle that in her own Mark one third of all my Sheep one Cow only excepted

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Robert Campen one Negro boy known by the name of Toms one Negro Girl known by the name of Grace one feather bed and furniture all the Cattle that in his own mark one third of all my Sheep only that Cow before excepted. one Iron pot Two pair of pot Tramonils Two horses Two Chest one large the other Small and all my Lands and Plantation to him and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever and for want of such Heirs To my Daughter Elizabeth Campen and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten for ever

Ever and for want of such Heirs To my Daughter Dorothy Campen and the heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever and for want of such heirs to John Jun Campen Son of John Campen and the heirs of his body lawfully begotten forever

Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Dorothy Campen one Negro wench known by the Name of Lin one Negro girl known by the Name of Esther all the Cattle that in her own mark one Black Heffer that in my own mark one third part of my Sheep one Cow before Excepted. one feather bed and furniture one Small Iron pot and one Small Iron Kettle one Discable Chest

Item I Doe leave my Negro Wench Rose to be hired or sold at the Discretion of my Brother Robert to pay Debts and for the use of my Children in General

Item As to what Pewter I have and Everthing Elce I have not

already mentioned I Doe Give to my Son Robert Campen. Except three plates and one Basons I here Give to Each of Two Daughters namely Elizabeth and Dorothy

I Doe make Ordain Constitute and appoint my brother Robert Campen sole and Sole Exr of this my Last Will and Testament Signed Seal and Subscribed in the Presence of us

In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Ode one of Beaufort County Being sick and weak But of Sound mind and memory Do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and as followeth

Item I give unto my loving Brother Antony Wherry my Negro Woman Gin my Negro Girls Dinah Betty Sarah and Negro boy Samer and my Will is that Brother Antony Wherry Pay my Sister Mary Tills Seventy Pounds Proc out of the negroes before mentioned

Item I give unto my Sister Sarah Flaniken my Large pray Book one Bed and furniture and my Horse Saddle and Bridle I also give her the use of my negro fellow four years In case she should live so long and if she should die Before then the said negro to go to Jno Smead

Item I Give unto the Col. my negro woman Bess

Item I Give unto Sarah Cording my Ring and a pr of Silver Shoe Buckles and one my my Loone and the gear Belonging to her

Item I Give unto my friend Sornelle Barrow Daughter Honey Barrow my Bible and one Heffer

Item I Give unto Col Barrows Daughter Sarey my Chest of Drawers and my Gold Buttons

Item I Give unto my Cousin Hamack Smead a Gold Ring and Silver Girdle Buckle and my Silver Tea Spoons long

and summer I also give to Jno Smau my negro fellow after the expiration of the four year before mentioned is out I also give him all the Resh of my Estate that is not before mentioned - my wearing apparel Excepted which I leave to be Equally Divided between my Sister Mary Miles and Caden Hannah Smau. I also appoint my Brother Antony Wherry and Jno Smau to sole Exors of this my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Twenty Second Day of April 1770

Item I do hereby lend to my beloved wife the Manner Plantation during her Life it is my desire that my beloved wife should have the use of my whole Personal Estate during her Life. it is my Desire that when my Son Peter Arrives to the years of Twenty one, that the Increase of my Negro wench named Kae should be Equally Divided Between all my Children Item I give and Bequeath to my Son Abraham a certain Tract

of Land Commonly known by the Name of the first or second Galt to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give & Bequeath to my Son Peter the Manner Plantation to him and his Heirs forever

Item It is my Desire that after the death of my beloved wife that my whole Personal Estate should be Divided Between my Children as follows. Between my Daughter Margaret, my Son Abraham, my Son Peter, my Daughter Sarah, my Daughter Mary & my Daughter Grace to them & their Heirs forever

I do hereby appoint my beloved friend Phillip Pritchett Esq & my beloved wife Exors of this my Last Will & Testament Signed Sealed & Published in Presence of

This will was proved by Thos Evans in this Manner He being first sworn in Court deposed that Peter Pritchett within named in his lifetime & last sickness desired him to write his will which he did by direction of the said Peter in the Manner as herein Expressed & when he had wrote the same he delivered it to the said Peter who Read it & approved of the same and he believed the reason it was not signed at that time there wanted witnesses to be present
