In the Name of God Amen. I James Adams of the County of Beaufort & Province of N Carolina. Gentlemen Being very Sick & Weak of Body But of Perfect Sense & memory thanks be to God for the same & knowing the certainty of Death that it is appointed for all men once to Die do make this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following First & Principally I commend my Soul into the hands of God who gave it & my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named nothing doubting but hoping that I shall receive full Pardon of all my Sins through the merits and intercession of my Blessed Saviour

Jesus Christ. and as to my Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Endow me with I lend give - - -

- - - following my just and Lawful Debts being first paid Item I lend unto my beloved wife Mary Adams the use of the third part of my Manor Plantation & all houses thereon & utensils therunto belonging with the third part of my household furniture one third part of my Cattle Sheep hogs & horses running at said plantation also I lend unto my said wife the Intire use of my Negro wench called Rosannah for the Term of five years my Negro man called Dincond & Negro woman called Bell one white Breeding Mare my Riding horse the remaining part of my Land - - - not given below and the third part of what is belonging to Mary mentioned in this Will during her Natural life & after her decease to be equally divided between my Son James & my Daughter Dorothy & my Daughter Winnifred

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son James & to his heirs forever my Manor Plantation with all houses & Improvements whatsoever referring the use of one third part to my beloved wife as before directed also I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son James one hundred acres of Land laying up on the head of Old Town brook also one Lot of Land laying in Bath Town also one hundred acres of Land on the head of Newton Run up Blounts Creek also one Negro man named Jany one Negro Boy called Isaac one Chest of Drawers one Desk one Looking Glass six Chairs one New Bed & Furniture one third part of my Cattle Sheep & hogs running at my Manor Plantation also my Station one Dor plates one Basson two Dishes one Iron Pot one third part of all such things that are not disposed off by this will with six Silver Spoons

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Dorothy Goodard & to her heirs forever one hundred acres of Land laying on the head of Shepards Run up Blounts Creek together with the Plantation of Stock therunto Belonging & one track land containing six hundred & forty acres therunto joining also one Bed & furniture six chairs one Iron Pot one Dor plates two Dishes two Bassons one Negro gire called Rose & one Breeding Mare & Colt

Item I lend unto my Daughter Ann Dunston the use of two hundred acres of Land Laying up South Dividing Creek beginning upon Long Creek & also the use of my Negro man

called Titus & all the Cattle she hath now of mine in her care
also the use of one Dozen Plates two Dishes one Basson one Pot
one Breeding Mare & Black horse bock to be delivered to her three
months after my Decease for my Grand Daughter

Here I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary Dunston
& to her heirs all the above Land & Negro Titus & household furniture
& household Furniture lent to her Mother Anne Dunston as above
all which shall be delivered to said Mary at the age of Eighteen
or day of marriage which shall first happen

Here I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Annifred & to her heirs
forever my Plantation lying at the mouth of North Diving
Creek with a third part of all my Cattle & hogs running at my
Manner Plantation & above said Plantation also one Negro wo
man called Rosannah & the first child she shall bare to be de
livered to her five years after my decease also one Bed & furniture
Six Chairs one Doz plates two Dishes one Basson one Pot & one
Breeding Mare & bock

& I do also declare this to be my last Will & Testament & do ap
point my beloved wife Mary Adams Executrix & my beloved Son
James Adams Executor of this my last Will & Testament The
Far Kill I have now on hand I leave for the use of my Family

Seventeenth Day of October 1758

or Adminrs all my Stock of Beut Cattle and Sheep Horses and
Hogs together with all my Household Furniture and every Part
& parcel of my Personal Estate whatsoever after Payment of
my just Debts and Legacies herein after mentioned Provided
all nevertheless upon this Special Trust and Confidence that
my Dear Loving Wife Eleanor Harfoot shall be and remain
in Possession of my said Plantation and Personal Estate
and have the use thereof During her natural life I do
likewise constitute & ordain my Loving wife Eleanor Har
foot my whole and Sole Executrix of this my last Will and
Testament. I do therefore Disannul and Revoke all former
Wills Legacies and bequests before mentioned Ratifying
and confirming this and no Other to be my last and Testament
Witness my Hands and Seals this Seventeenth Day of December
Anno Domini 1758.
