Item I Give my Grand Daughter Margret Tuley twenty pounds current
money of this province
Item I Give the use of my Inner Room to my Grand Daughter Margret
Wilkinson until her Death or marriage Day, and all my other Estate Deb
ts and Credit not heretofore mentioned, Excepting one other bed to my
Grand Daughter Margret Wilkinson omitted mentioning before which I
now will Give to her the said Margret, and then all my other Estate not
given in Legacies to be Equally Divided Between my two Sons Thomas for
dun and John Jordan which two Sons and my Son in Law Zachariah
Barrow I constitute and appoint Executors of this my Last Will and
Testament hereby Ratifying and confirming this to be my Last Will
& Testament.

Item I Give to my Son Robert Campaign one hundred and Fifty Acres of Land lying at the upper end of the plantation and all the Cattle that was Markt for him and one Eve and Lamb and one Bea To him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Thos Campaign all the Cattle that markt for him one Gun one Stock Bess To him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Son Joseph Campaign one Cow and Calf one Dry Cow and one Cow yearling one Bea To him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Brother Benjamin Campaign a part of Negro his heirs forever

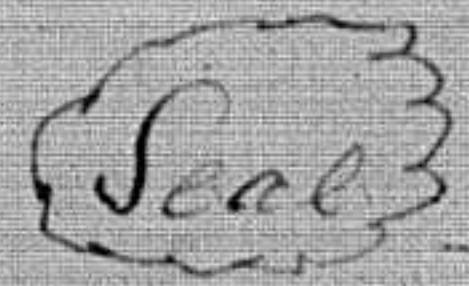
