Item To my Daughter Sally Elizabeth Murfree Dale Coakley I give negroes Adams Jack and Betty to her and the Lawful Issue of her body forever and in case of Dying without Lawful Issue to be divided between the Surviving Heirs of my Sister Elizabeth Hill that is after the Death of my Husband Benjamin Coakley who is expressly to keep possession during his Natural Life for the express purposes first herein mentioned unless by him Deemed expedient to lend the use of or Deliver over for such purposes as he may think proper any part thereof for use and Support of my Daughter Sally above and before named

Item To my Daughter Mary Murfree Dale Coakley I give my negroes Jim. Abram & Edey to her and the Lawful Issue of her body forever and in case of dying without Lawful Issue of her body to be divided between the Surviving Heirs of my body if any living if none between the Heirs of my Sister Elizabeth Hill that is after the Death of my Husband Benjamin Coakley who is expressly to keep possession during his Natural Life for the express purposes first herein mentioned unless by him Deemed expedient to lend or give over the use of any part thereof for use and Support of my Daughter Mary Murfree Dale herein before named And Lastly now so it is the negroes herein before named and Devised to my Children herein before named and as I have before Stated is to be and remain in the Pleasable and Quiet possession of my Husband Ben Coakley for the express purpose of raising and Educating each and Every of them and for his and their Support and by him in his Lifetime and pleasure to lend or give over to their use when of age or married and hath Lawful Issue to enable them to receive by Loan or otherwise their or any part of their distributive Share he the said

Ben Coakley may deem or find it expedient to Lend or Deliver over for their Benefit or Either of them and it is my further Will and desire that my wearing apparel be Delivered over to my Sister Elyz Hill to be Divided between my Children or used by herself in such way and such manner as my Sister Elizabeth Hill shall think advisable who is hereby trusted with the Sole Disposition thereof as she shall think expedient in any way whatever and I do hereby appoint my beloved Husband Benjamin Coakley and Son Ben. Dale Coakley Executors of this my Last Will and testament Hereby revoking all other Wills In faith & testimony whereof I said Sally Coakley hath hereunto set my hand & Seal & acknowledged this to be my last Will & Testament at Washington Beaufort County May 28th 1804

In the Name of God Amen I Richard Hollors of the County of Beaufort and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of Sound disposed mind and memory Thanks be to god for it and calling to mind the mortality of all flesh and knowing that it was appointed for me once to die and after that to Judgment do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in manner and forme following that is to say first of all I recommend my Soul to god who gave it my body to be buried in a decent Christian like manner as to my worldly goods that it has pleased god to bless me with in this life it is my Will and desire to dispose of in the following manner to wit Item it is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate if a nought without selling of any negroe if in case there should be a necessity of selling one of the negroes it is my desire that my Executors shall see my negroe boy named Jess at publick Sale

Item I lend to my beloved wife Sarah Hollors my negroe woman Beck my negroe boy Ben and my negroe girl Blue during

her life and at her death I give and bequeath the fore mentioned negroes Beck Ben and Gloc to my daughter Sophiee Hallon and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Sarah Holland twenty five pound out of my Estate to her and her heirs forever

Item it is my desire that if my Executors can settle my debts with out selling of my negro boy Jess I say when that may happen then I give my negro boy Jess to my daughter Sophiee Holland and her heirs forever

Item Should it be the case that the negro Jess is sold it is my desire that the over plus after paying my debts be applyed to the use of raising and schooling of my daughter Sophiee Holland

Item I lend unto my beloved Wife Sarah Holland one feather bed and furniture during her life

and at my wifes death then I give the said bed and furniture to my daughter Sophiee Holland and her heirs forever

Item all the rest of my Estate not before mentioned I leave to be sold to discharge my debts I constitute and appoint Charles Holland and Isaac Barrow my whole and Sole Executors of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have here unto sett my hand and seal this 9 day of November 1804

In the Name of God Amen I Cornelius Patrick of the State of North Carolina and County of Beaufort Being of Sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God do this tenth day of November in the year of our Lord 1804 make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say

First I lend to my beloved Wife Ann the plantation whereon I now live until my youngest Child arrives to the age of Eighteen years and at that time my will is that all my lands and all my property of every kind be equally divided between my wife and Children

Secondly My will is that my Negroe man Chatham be hired out annually for the benefit of my wife and children but if my Executrix and

Executor think it more advantageous they are hereby empowered to sell the said negro on a credit of six months and the money arising from the sale to be by them laid out in the purchase of another for the benefit of my wife and children

Thirdly The money which is due me from Holton Johnson I wish collected and to be by my Executrix and Executor laid out in the purchase of a Negro woman or Girl for the benefit of my wife and children

Fourthly My will is that my Household and Kitchen furniture plantation utensils and stock of all kinds (except my old horse which is to be sold) remain for the use of my wife and children during her widowhood or to the time of the division and then to be sold agreeable to Law

Fifthly I wish that the debts that is due me be collected and after my debts is paid as much of the money as may be necessary be applyed to build another chimney to the house I live in and the House to be repaired so as to make it comfortable and to build a framed Kitchen sixteen feet square to be placed at the end of the House I live in and the Chimney to be built with two fire places

Sixthly & lastly I nominate my wife Ann my Executrix and my friend Reading Grist Executor to this my last will and testament I witness whereof I the said Cornelius Patrick have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and date above written
