Item I give and Bequeath to my Son John a Cow calf to be for his Support But to be in the Care of my Wife and me for

to me to overlook

Item I give and Bequeath to my Two Sons David and Barzilea each of them a Cow Calf and their Increase to be for them and their heirs forever. I give to my well beloved Son Jesse Hoeten My Best Sward to him and his heirs forever.

Item that whereof I have given to my three sons that is Jesse Hoeten, George Hoeten & James Hoeten each of them Land and a feather bed and furniture and cattle and hogs and Sheep I therefore will that each and all the of them shall quietly have hold possess and enjoy all such Goods and Chattels and Breeds as they have now in Possession that hath here to fore been Given to them By me as their full part and Portion my personal Estait they and their heirs forever. I likewise Desire that my Beloved Wife shall keep all my Moveable Estait in her possession during her Natural life if she Remain a Widdo to Support herself and my female Children or But if my wife should marrie then for a Division of my Estait to be Made and my Beloved Wife to have her thirds and the Remainin part to be Equally Divided between my fore Sons that is Perigen John & David & Barzilea. Item If my wife should Remain a widow as my Sons come of age that if she see she can keep them to their parts without hurting herself it is my Desier she should otherwise to stand and Remain in my Wifes care if she Remain a Widdo till her Decese and then to be Equely Divided as aforesaid to my fore Sons

as aforementioned to them and their heirs forever.
